



Community Thanksgiving Service





Burkhead in the Community

Perhaps you missed hearing about some of the ways Burkhead has been reaching out in the community recently. We made and served two meals to the Mt. Tabor High School football team. About 65 Mt. Tabor students were fed each time. Backpack Meals are delivered every Friday to students at Speas Elementary School to help feed them over the weekend. Twice every month Burkhead folks make



sandwiches and put together lunch bags for 100 children which are delivered on Sunday afternoon by H.O.P.E. Burkhead joined the CROP Hunger Walk and our team of walkers (Joni and Durwood Howell and Murray and Gale Sink) were supported by the congregation with donations totaling \$645



which will go to Crisis Control Ministry and Church World Service. Burkhead participated in Peace Haven's Chick-fil-A Community Fall Festival with a table with activities and treat bags as well as information about the church. A meal has been cooked to deliver to Open Arms

Community on November 7th to feed about 35 people at the adult Bible Study which is held there each Wednesday night. Each Thursday, Burkhead folks, along with other volunteers, hold a Reading Program for 20 to 25 children at Open Arms Community. Additionally, the children receive books from the Little Free Library that Burkhead placed there. They also have special opportunities to go on field trips and attend community events such as the Bookmarks Festival and Bethabara Band Concert and visits to libraries, museums, the fire station, and other fun places.



This is just a brief list of some of the ways we are reaching out. Thank you to everyone who has helped with all of these projects. Have you found your place to serve? If you didn't see yourself in the list above or in the other ways you may be serving, contact any member of the Outreach Committee and they can help you find a way to get involved.



How To Pack A Shoebox:



Life Line Screening at BUMC - December 4, 2018

Life Line Screening will be returning to Burkhead on December 4th. A provider of preventive health screenings, they offer 5 different screenings that scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries which is a leading cause of stroke; abdominal aortic aneurysms which can lead to a ruptured aorta; hardening of the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening (for men and women) used to assess the risk of osteoporosis. The cost of a Wellness Package which includes the 5 tests discussed above is \$149 (\$139 with our member discount). Separate tests are priced separately. All screenings take 60-90 minutes to complete. **In order to register for this event and to receive a \$10 discount off any package priced above \$129, please call 1-888-653-6441 or visit www.lifelinescreening.com/communitycircle or text the word "circle" to 797979.**
