**November Financial Report:**

Total Received	\$42,091	\$281,189
Total Spent	\$17,844	\$238,565

All expenditures were for normal operating expenses. All obligations were paid. ALL of our conference and District apportionments have now been paid for the year! \$60,160 of the total received to date was for the Capital Campaign, making total received for Capital Campaign for both years of \$76,960.

We had a very good month in November for budget contributions, however, this did not overcome our shortage that occurred in the third quarter. Hopefully, December's contributions will make up for our overall shortage for the year. And remember, we missed one Sunday due to snow!

We have received 29 pledges for the 2019 budget. These 29 total \$131,920, which is only 51% of our proposed budget of \$258,392. We are praying that more pledges will be coming in during the next few weeks.

### New Wednesday Meal Schedule

The Church Council agreed to the suggestion that the Wednesday Night meals go to **TWO nights a month instead of every Wednesday**. (Except in March with Ash Wednesday.) The new schedule is posted on the Information Bulletin board.

There are several reasons for this but the major one is that the attendance has slipped, especially with several of the meals. When the Meal Team spends the time to prepare a meal and only 15-18 people show up it 1) may not even cover the expense of the meal, and 2) the team has put in a lot of hours for just a few people. Another reason is the lack of volunteers to help with clean up. The fact that it gets dark early now does prevent some from attending during the winter and that was taken into consideration.

**Nothing is final.** If attendance gets better and people decide they want more meals and will support the meals by attending and helping, the decision will be reconsidered. We really want everyone to enjoy the meal time. If you have comments, pro or con, please contact Betty Bewley. **Come join the fun!** The cost is \$6 for adults. Children and first timers eat free. ## Epiphany, the Feast of the Three Kings

Epiphany is celebrated 12 days after Christmas on **January 6th** (or January 19th for the Orthodox Churches who celebrate Christmas on January 7th). It is the time when Christians remember the Wise Men (also called the Three Kings) who visited Jesus.

Epiphany is also when some churches remember Jesus' baptism, when he was about 30, and he started to teach people about God. Epiphany means 'revelation' and both the visit of the Wise Men and his baptism are special times when Jesus was 'revealed' to be very important.
