2018 BBQ PROCEEDS

Now that all expenses are paid and all proceeds totaled, it is time to designate the proceeds. The actual total was \$5504.75, but it was rounded up to \$5,505.

The Church members who could attend a BBQ meeting met in the Fellowship Hall on Sunday, February 3rd, at 9:45 am. First the members heard how well we did and then proceeded to discuss where to place the money. There was great discussion and great suggestions on where. We all agreed that there are many charities that need help. The following was agreed on but asked that there be an article in the March newsletter to inform all members where and give all the opportunity to agree or disagree. If anyone disagrees with any of the suggestions, please inform Beth Dixon by March 5. If no one responds, the proceeds will be disbursed as follows:

- Due to the Major Project needs for the Church's roof and windows, the extra \$500 will be applied to that project. The less money the church has to borrow, the better off we are.

Therefore, the BBQ Proceeds of \$5,505 will be disbursed as follows:

1. The Trustees Fund for the use of the Fellowship Hall and hallway during the BBQ will receive \$505.
2. Major Projects for the windows and roof will receive \$1000,
3. Catholic Charities, A Storehouse for Jesus, Open Arms, H.O.P.E. (Help Our People Eat), UMCOR, Salvation Army, Battered Women's Shelter, and Rescue Mission will receive \$500 each.

The BBQ Committee thanks all volunteers for their hard work and dedication to make the BBQ Fundraiser successful.

Please inform Beth Dixon by March 5th if you disagree with the BBQ proceeds disbursement. Thanks.
