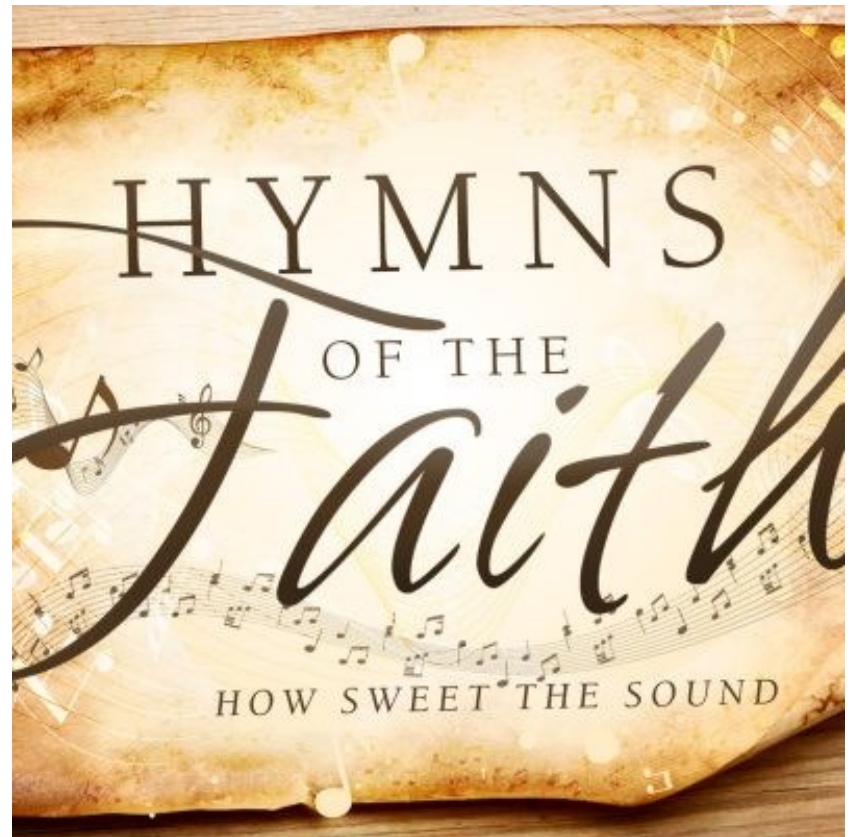

Our **Softball** team starts their season **Monday, April 1st at 6:30 pm** on Washington Park field #4. Please come to support these men and cheer them on!

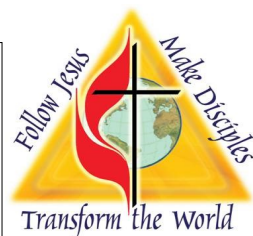
Join us **Tuesday at 6:30 pm** in the Parlor for **Bible Study and Discussion**. The scripture this week is Matthew 21:1-11.
