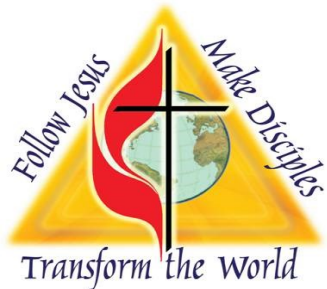
Souper Bowl of Caring
