

On November 21 at 4 pm in the Fellowship Hall, Burkhead will hold its annually scheduled Charge Conference. What will we do and who needs to attend? The Charge Conference, which must be presided over by a fully ordained United Methodist Elder (in this case Rev. Ross O'Neal), may be attended by any of the members or constituents of the church, and attendance is expected of current members of the Church Council. The meeting should be brief, but there are several important actions to be taken. Among them:



We will hear the pastor's report. We will approve the Clergy Compensation for 2022. We will vote on the election of the slate of officers presented by the Committee on Nominations and Lay Leadership. And we will approve the apportionments for 2022.

What are apportionments?

Apportioned funding is a way of giving that proportionally allocates the churchwide budget for payment by conferences and local churches. A local church or annual conference's assigned portion of giving supports international, national and conference ministries. The apportionment is not based on number of members or numbers of persons in attendance, but on a calculation of what we spend on ministry within the church.

Because we are a connectional church, we work together, as a connection, to support the wider church. But what specifically, do those funds support? I would invite you to turn to a well written resource offered by the United Methodist Church at https://www.umc.org/en/content/askthe-umc-does-the-umc-fund.

If there is interest within the congregation, I would be glad to host a discussion on the topic of funding for the UMC. Speak up and let me know. Thank you.

Christmas Pajama Event


Any child aged 12 months to 18 years will receive a warm blanket, pajamas, and a book!


