


A Word from our Pastor

February is the month we celebrate love, and observe Black History Month, and celebrate Transfiguration Sunday. My suggestion for a book which might cover those several bases and perhaps will hit a home run for you as it did for me (pointing out that Spring Training also begins in February), is **Love Is the Way: Holding on to Hope in Troubling Times** by Bishop Michael B. Curry and Sara Grace (published 2020 by Penguin Random House). Bishop Curry is the presiding bishop of the Episcopal Church. Elected in 2015, he is the first African-American to lead the denomination. He was previously bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of North Carolina. Bishop Curry is recognized as one of the most popular preachers in the English language. You may remember him as the preacher who gave the wedding homily for Prince Harry and Meghan Markle, which made quite an impression, invoking the words of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and the lyrics of an African-American spiritual to speak to royalty (and all of us) of what love can do.

From Love Is the Way: "The Bible says, "Choose this day who you will serve." I believe, and I suspect most of you do, too, that we must choose community—the human community, in community with all of creation. This is the beloved community of God. This is what the late lay theologian Verna Dozier and Archbishop Desmond Tutu have often called "the dream of God." And love—unselfish, sacrificial, unconditional, and liberating love—is the way, frankly the only way, to realize God's dream of the beloved community, on earth as it is in heaven. It's the only thing that can, and that ever will, make the world a better place."

I plan on re-reading **Love Is the Way** during February as it contains lessons that can be (or need to be) re-learned. Won't you join me? Then let's <u>discuss it together at 3:00 pm over coffee and</u> <u>dessert at the parsonage on Transfiguration Sunday, February 27th</u>.

Another bit of news from Open Arms is that they **hope to purchase a new van soon**. The current van is very old. I have ridden in the van and there is no air conditioning and the automatic windows only work from the driver's side. The doors must be locked manually. The van is used at least weekly if not more to pick up children to be tutored and to take the youth group on outings when they have a field trip.
